

## WHAT IS A LAND TRUST?

A land trust is a local, non-profit organization formed by the citizens of a community to protect land for its natural, recreational, scenic, historical, or productive value. It depends on volunteer leadership and support, and brings together a wide range of people, who all care about the future of their community. Once established, a land trust is a perpetual organization that continues to pursue its conservation goals and oversee land under its direction for generations. A trust can purchase or accept donations of land or conservation easements, manage land owned by others, or advise land-owners on how to preserve their land. It may also help negotiate conservation transactions in which it plays no other role. A land trust is not a political organization, and it is not a branch of town or state government, but often works cooperatively with these agencies to acquire or manage land, or assist in the development of open space plans. A trust may also work with other non-profit organizations and developers to ensure that important land use decisions are openly discussed and prudently implemented.



*The reason Colchester is such a desirable place to live has much to do with its rural nature, abundance of natural resources, and the amount of open space and undeveloped land that still exists. However, these are all at risk as development continues at such a rapid pace.*

Unwise development decisions can (and will if left unchecked) change the very qualities of Colchester that we all enjoy today. Under the current plan of development and zoning regulations, the Town of Colchester could be developed to a population of 40,000 residents. Can you imagine what our town would look like with over three times the number of residents that we have today? It is unnerving to see how few large pieces of property are left in town, and how quickly they could disappear -- forever! *We strongly urge all Colchester residents to become members and support the Colchester Land Trust.* Please read our mission statement and goals, and assist us in our effort to keep Colchester a wonderful place to live for generations to come.

### LAND DONATION

Some of the donation options are:

#### OUTRIGHT DONATION

This can relieve you of managing the land and can provide substantial income tax deductions and estate benefits. And, most importantly, the land will be protected.

#### DONATING A REMAINDER INTEREST IN LAND

You can continue to live on donated land by donating a remainder interest and retaining a reserved life estate.

#### DONATING LAND BY WILL

You donate your land but still own and control it during your lifetime when you donate it by will. This assures that your land is protected after your death.

#### BARGAIN SALE OF LAND

You sell your land for less than its fair market value. This makes it affordable for the land trust while it provides you with cash, a reduction in capital gains tax, and entitles you to a charitable income tax deduction.

#### CONSERVATION EASEMENT

The Land Trust can help you create a legal agreement to limit the uses of your land to protect its conservation values. You can maintain ownership of your land, and even sell it or pass it on to heirs. An easement may also qualify as a tax-deductible charitable donation.
